Free Tool Lets Schengen Visa Applicants Instantly Verify Insurance Compliance

New digital tool helps Schengen visa applicants confirm that their travel insurance meets Schengen visa requirements — quickly, privately, and for free.

[Paris, France] — [October 8, 2025] — A new tool for Schengen visa applicants has been launched to help simplify one of the most important parts of the Schengen visa application process: travel insurance.

For visa applications, Schengen travel insurance has to meet specific requirements. This free, no-signup tool allows visa applicants to instantly verify whether or not their policy meets official Schengen visa requirements, including validity across all 29 Schengen countries and minimum €30,000 emergency medical coverage.

Unlike many online calculators and tools, the Schengen Travel Insurance Checker does not collect personal data or even require an email address. Users can check any policy from any

provider, anywhere in the world, and get details about whether or not their policy meets the minimum requirements - all in under 1 minute.

"Our goal was to create something simple, transparent, and accessible to anyone, anywhere in the world," said Clément Goubon, CMO of Insurte.

"Visa applicants shouldn't have to cross their fingers and hope that their travel insurance is valid before they submit their applications, or risk having their visas rejected over a technicality. This tool gives them the knowledge they need."

In 2024 alone, **over 11 million Schengen visa applications** were submitted worldwide, according to official EU statistics. Applicants can experience **delays or rejections** due to incorrect or incomplete travel insurance coverage.

The new checker enables travelers to catch and fix such issues **before submitting their applications**, saving time, stress, and money.

"The Schengen Travel Insurance Checker brings peace of mind to travelers, as well as transparency to a process that can feel overwhelming," said Goubon, "Whether someone bought their policy from a major brand or a small provider, they deserve clarity and confidence going into the visa application process."

Key features

Free and anonymous: No account creation or emails required.

Universal compatibility: Works with any travel insurer, worldwide, and can be used by anyone, anywhere.

Instant information: Notifies travelers whether a policy meets visa requirements in under 1 minute.

Helpful guidance: Offers insider tips for travelers and gives next steps for those whose policies fall short of requirements.

Why It Matters

Schengen travel insurance is **mandatory** for anyone applying for a Schengen visa. In 2024, for example over 200,000 US residents applied for Schengen visas. This doesn't even take into consideration long-stay visa applications.

Notably, Schengen travel insurance must include **especially**:

- Minimum coverage of **€30,000 for medical emergencies**,
- Coverage for **repatriation costs**, and
- Validity **throughout all Schengen member states** for the entire trip duration.

Failure to meet these criteria is one of the top reasons visa applications are rejected.

The Schengen Travel Insurance Checker simplifies this step and helps travelers understand their policies - quickly and securely.
